**ELIGIBILITY**

All riders must be members of an ACU Club and hold a current ACU or SACU competition licence and have passed their **16th birthday**. One event licences will be available (price £10) if a rider does not hold a valid competition licence. Riders from any other FM including Irish participants must produce Start Permission and confirmation from that FM that they are licenced and insured.

**ENTRIES**

Completed entry forms must be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting together with the entry fee, £110.00, which is payable by cheque or postal order to **Rhayader M.C. & L.C.C. Ltd**. This fee includes the premium for insurance as required by the ACU, as detailed in ESR30. Entry fees, less an administration charge (10%) will only be refunded in the event of cancellation of the enduro **or** on receipt of a doctors certificate confirming incapacity. No refunds will be issued after the 1st August.

**Closing date:** 1st August 2009 **or** when full.

Maximum number of entries: 180

**Acceptance of entries** will be by date of receipt of a **fully** completed entry form complete with the appropriate remittance. Incomplete entries **will** be returned.

**VENUE**

The event will start & finish at Cwmythig Hill, St Harmon (B4518), nr Rhayader, Mid-Wales. It will be Signposter from Rhayader.

**START (BOTH DAYS)** .....9:00am

Riders will start in the following order: Championship, Expert, Clubman.

## **MACHINE EXAMINATION**

Competitors should present their machines for scrutineering on Friday 21 August between 16.00 and 18.30 hours. See Security regarding Parc Ferme arrangements.

**TYRES - ALL CLASSES:** Front AND Rear - Enduro type to FIM specification.

**RIDER NUMBERS:** Riders to provide their own numbers and backgrounds making sure that there is space on each number plate to attach the BEC sponsor logos (to be supplied) without obscuring or altering the logo as per BEC regulations. Also please ensure that backgrounds are fitted accordance with Enduro standing regulations

## **SECURITY**

Machines **will be** parked overnight Friday and Saturday in the park ferme (secured and guarded).

## **SIGNING ON**

Competitors to sign on between 16:00 - 18:30 on Friday 21st August at the start area.

## **COURSE**

The lap milage will be approximately 40 miles with five time controls per lap. Accurate milage between controls will be stated within the Final Instructions. **Riders must ensure that their machine is fully road legal.** The course will be marked with orange dayglo arrows on day 1 & green dayglo arrows on day 2.

## **SPECIAL TEST**

The test will be available for inspection from 9.00am on Friday 21st August and starts and finishes within the start area.

**CLASSES**                      Championship / Expert / Clubman / Veteran (Over 40)

### **SUB CLASSES**

E1 2T      Two strokes 100 - 125cc

E1 4T      Four stroke 175cc - 250cc

E2              Two strokes 175 - 250cc & four strokes 290 - 450cc

E3              Two strokes 290 - 500cc & four strokes 475 - 650cc

(NB No sub classes in Veteran/Over 40 and will run on Clubman times).

**AWARDS:** - Best Overall performance & Runner-Up in each class

**Environmental Mats:** Where refuelling or servicing of a motorcycle is being undertaken, riders must provide and use an environmental mat to protect the ground. These mats are to be removed by the competitors after use. The minimum dimensions of the mat will be at least equal to the wheelbase of the motorcycle and of the width of the handlebars.
